"I'm setting the pace for the rest of the firm," says Greif, who heads the mergers and acquisitions group at the California investment bank. "Either I have to slow down, or the firm's got to hustle." As the top producer at Sutro since 1984, Greif has helped boost its annual volume of M&A and LBO



deals 30-fold, to \$950 million, even though the deal market has fallen off a bit of late. Fee income has jumped to \$12 million. Earlier this year he put together Sutro's biggest deal ever: the \$269 million acquisition of Bumble Bee tuna by Thailand's Unicord Co. Greif, who has an MBA and a law degree, joined Sutro in 1981. He rose quickly to become the youngest executive VP and board member in its 131-year history. When not chasing deals, he hunts wild boar.
